## 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Dear Friends in Christ,

Time keeps on flying by. We will soon be celebrating the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe at the end of November and then the Holy Season of Advent will begin. It makes me think of some big events that seem very far away but will be here before we know it.
