**Macaroni and Ground Meat Casserole**

**RECIPE:** 1 lb. Macaroni  
2 lbs. Ground Beef, Turkey, Pork, or Veal  
32 oz. Jar Spaghetti Sauce  
Onion and/or Green Pepper (optional)  
Shredded Cheese (optional)

**DIRECTIONS:**

Brown the ground meat, onion, and pepper. Cook macaroni, drain. Mix all ingredients together in an oiled casserole pan. Cover with foil, crimp edges and refrigerate or freeze.

**THIS DISH NEEDS NO BAKING IN YOUR HOME.**

**HELPFUL HINTS:**

- Casserole may be made in advance and frozen.
- Spray the underside of aluminum foil with Pam, Mazola, etc. to keep from sticking to casserole when reheated. *(Be sure the pan is completely covered with foil)*
- If adding cheese, mix it into casserole; do not leave on top.
- If casserole looks dry, add tomato juice, canned tomatoes, or additional sauce.
