# July 7, 2024 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

## *Dear Parishioners of Blessed Sacrament and Saint Matthew Parishes:*

We are pleased to join you as these seven parishes (St Anthony of Padua, Blessed Sacrament, St Dominic, St Francis of Assisi, St Matthew, Most Precious Blood, Shrine of the Little Flower) advance the endeavors of *Seek the City to Come*.

The months ahead will be a tough journey for us, as the parishes which collectively have provided 717 years of pastoral ministry in the Archdiocese will re-imagine themselves. The seven parishes have been a significant footprint in our varied neighborhoods beginning as early as 1884. It is not easy letting go of the familiar to embrace the unknown as we fashion a new footprint in the neighborhood. These months before us will be 'constant change.' Each parish will have its moment of closure throughout the late summer and fall as we journey to the First Sunday of Advent.

Saint Matthew Parish, though the seated parish, may have the most difficult task. It is not easy worshiping in the church you have known, knowing now that six other parishes will put their imprint on it soon. The other six parishes, not being the seated parish, know before they enter Saint Matthew Church, it will be different than what they had at their church.

Some of the immediate changes come from the practical side. Among the seven parishes there are presently nine masses that fulfill the Sunday obligation. **These first weeks of July: (July 6/7 and July 13/14 weekends) and weekday mass schedule for the seven parishes will remain the same.** Beginning July 15, the weekday mass schedule and weekend mass schedule will be amended. There will be seven masses each weekend, one mass per parish to fulfill the Sunday obligation. There will a daily mass at one of the churches each day.

*Seek the City to Come* requests that all parishes have a time of closure within the months of September, October, and November. The time for the seven closures will be staggered. As each church ceases having mass during this time frame, the mass schedule obviously will be altered as well. Again, these months will be one of 'constant change.' Hopefully when the new liturgical year begins on December 1<sup>st</sup> weekend (First Sunday of Advent) the mass schedule changes will be lessened.

Each of us have more questions than answers at this juncture. Please be patient with yourself and others, as we walk into this moment in our parishes' histories. Lastly, keep Father Matthew Buening in your prayers as he too walks into a new reality. It is not easy changing your place of work, moving into a new home and starting over. Let us give thanks to him for his leadership and ministry to Blessed Sacrament and St Matthew Parish.

We look forward to serving and being with you.

Henriette Delille was declared a Servant of God in 2010, the first step in the formal process of canonization. The Sisters of the Holy Family formally opened Delille's cause for canonization with the Catholic Church in 1989. In 2010, Pope Benedict XVI declared DeLille to be Venerable. A miracle attributed to her intercession was approved by a medical board in 2013, advancing her cause. Delille would become the first American-born black saint if the canonization process is successful.
